Almsgiving during Lent

During Lent, we are encouraged to be extra generous in our almsgiving to share our good fortune with those in greater need. As one of the three pillars of Lenten practice, almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God."

There are 2 collections during let that support those in need in the world:

- the **Share Lent** collection this weekend (March 16/17) This collection supports those in need around the world and this year theme is "Reaping Our Rights". The donations will go to support impoverished and rural communities across the Global South, working to defend their rights to land, water, biodiversity, justice, healthy and a healthy environment.
- the **Holy Land** collection on Good Friday (March 29) which supports the Christians in the Holy Lands and helps to preserve the sacred places connected with the life of Jesus. The ongoing war in Gaza has paralyzed the Holy Land. The lack of pilgrims and tourists has created extreme difficulties for thousands of families. The Holy Father intends launch a humanitarian project in Gaza and the Westbank and the Vatican dicastery has issued an appeal to ask Catholics around the world to generously support this year's collection for the Holy Land.

We encourage you open your hearts to give generously to these causes especially to the Holy Land.

New Appointment to Parish Finance Council at Our Lady of Fatima Parish

Effective March 19, 2024 on the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Fr. Au has appointed Mrs. Elizabeth Tippe to the parish Finance council for the next three (3) years. as established by the law of the Church, to assist the Pastor in managing the patrimony of the parish and the financial well being of the parish. Parish Finance Council assists the Pastor in the administration of parish temporal matters. An active, well-formed Parish Finance Council is a key element for promoting the financial health of a parish, assuring accountability and assisting the Pastor with his temporal responsibilities.

Canon 532 *"The Pastor represents the parish in all juridic affairs in accord with the norm of law; he is to see to it that the goods of the parish are administered in accord with the norms of canons 1281 - 1288."*

Canon 537 *"Each parish is to have a finance council which is regulated by the universal law as well as by norms issued by the diocesan bishop; in this council the Christian faithful, selected according to the same norms, aid the Pastor in the administration of parish goods with due regard for the prescription of canon 532."*

In order to be effective in their responsibilities as members of the Parish Finance Council, members should have a love of the Church and Her mission to save souls, as well as a thorough understanding of the parish's mission, goals, people and other resources. The members should have knowledge of diocesan statutes and policies regarding temporal issues and other financial matters.

For parents of Our Lady of Fatima School or Archbishop Carney Secondary students who have not yet attended a presentation, there is a **Parent Presentation on**
